All children have started this and it is working well. We are now commencing some of the activities to enhance their levels.

Outside of nursery

There will be a table outside nursery, on which we will put some cutting and sticking worksheets, if you would like to help your child at home please take one.

Also too the left of the main doors you can help yourself to our surplus books, toys bikes etc.

Road closure

I have just received advanced notice that Parkside Avenue / Cross will be closed from the 4th November for approximately 10 weeks for gas works.

Please bear in mind this will add to the parking issues around nursery.

Homework / Book work.

This will start for the older children this term who will be going to school next September.

The homework will come out on a Monday and returned whenever as we are preparing them for transition into mainstream schooling. This is not compulsory, but we believe this will be of benefit to all.

Activities we will be covering this term are "Jumping in coloured hoop" 1-2-3 worksheets, threading pasta PlayDoh, straws and many others.

Open day – Thursday 5th December

This provides the opportunity for parents to talk to their child's key person to see how they are progressing and to look around the nursery. The time the children will be singing Christmas songs for a short while is 9:15 a.m. Parents are welcome to stay until 11:00 a.m. The afternoon starts from 12:30 to 2:00 p.m. this will include Christmas Art activities and time to enjoy a cup of tea and cakes as well as having the opportunity to talk to their child's keyperson.

If it is not your child's session you are more than welcome to attend either one, so all parents can choose either morning or afternoon regardless of sessions. It would be helpful on managing numbers if you could let me have your preference, please? A board will be placed outside nursery nearer the time. Only two people per child can attend.

For a donation, tea, coffee, cakes will be available. Raffle tickets at a cost of 50p a strip will also be on sale with the draw to take place on Tuesday 10th December.

It would be nice if your child could wear Christmas jumpers or other forms of themed clothing.

Toileting rucksacks.

Please can your child only bring in a rucksack (MUST BE NAMED) if they need changing or are in nappies / pull-ups – please ensure you put spare ones in their bags. Please could your child come into nursery in a clean nappy as although we are more than happy to change them once they are settled.

If your child is currently out of nappies, to help them go more independently can you please put them in clothing that they can easily undo themselves.

Please note we will always have spare clothes in the event of an accident, can these please be returned to nursery once you have washed them?

Can you also please ensure both lunch boxes and drink bottles also be named.

If you are applying for a school place for your child, this must be in by 15th January 2025. If you feel you need to discuss this further, please come to see me. Schools have now announced their Open days and we encourage you to look around your choices as they are all so different.

January sessions.

If you would like to increase or decrease your sessions from January and you have not already told me can you please let me know asap?

We only have afternoon sessions available.

There will no room to change after January, as I will be full until September 2025 unless a child moves out of the area.

Christmas Party Tuesday 17th December.

This will be held in normal session times. This will consist of party games, with visits from Father Christmas and a snack.

Father Christmas will be giving out presents to all the children and photos will be taken at a cost of 50p which you can purchase in the new year.

Letters have been sent out in your child's book bag, can you let us know by Friday 15th November if they will be able to attend and the payment to please.

If it is not your child's session you are more than welcome to swap your session or pay £21 for the session.
